The finished fans brightened the home and were enjoyed long after the craft session had ended.

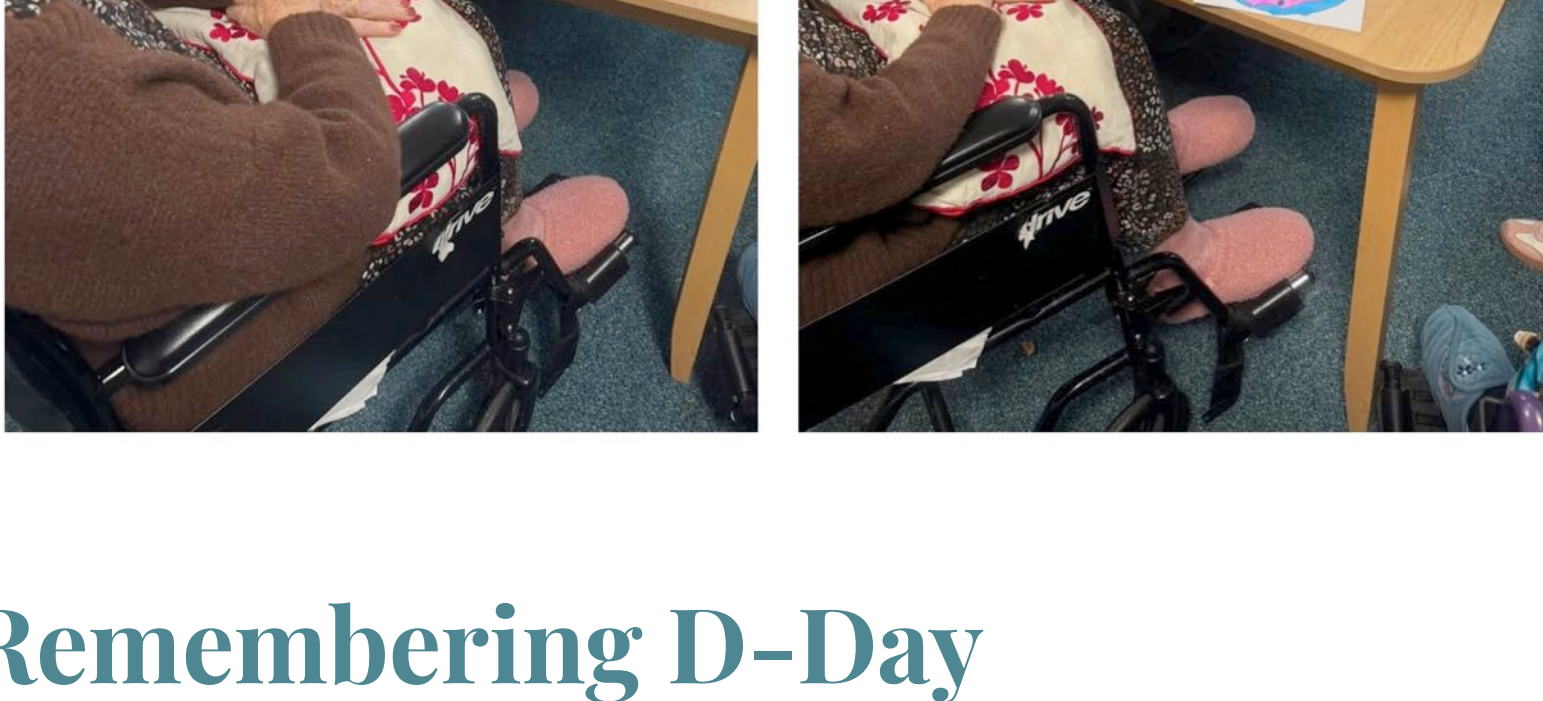


Fun with Greenacres Nursery

These visits are always a highlight for both generations, creating meaningful connections and bringing plenty of energy and smiles to the home.

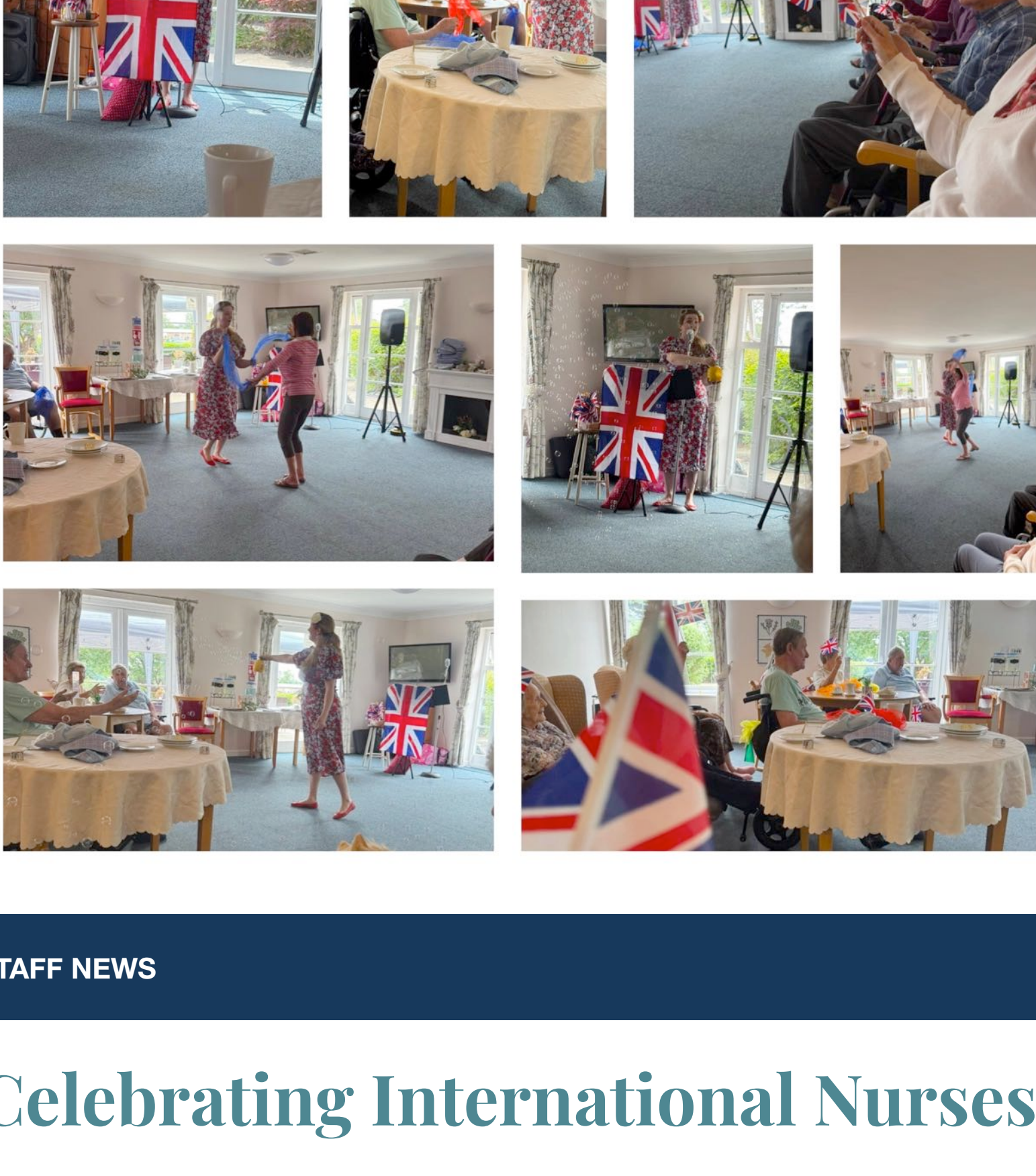


Remembering D-Day

Our nurses provide outstanding care every day, and it was a pleasure to celebrate their commitment and thank them for the kindness and professionalism they show to our residents.

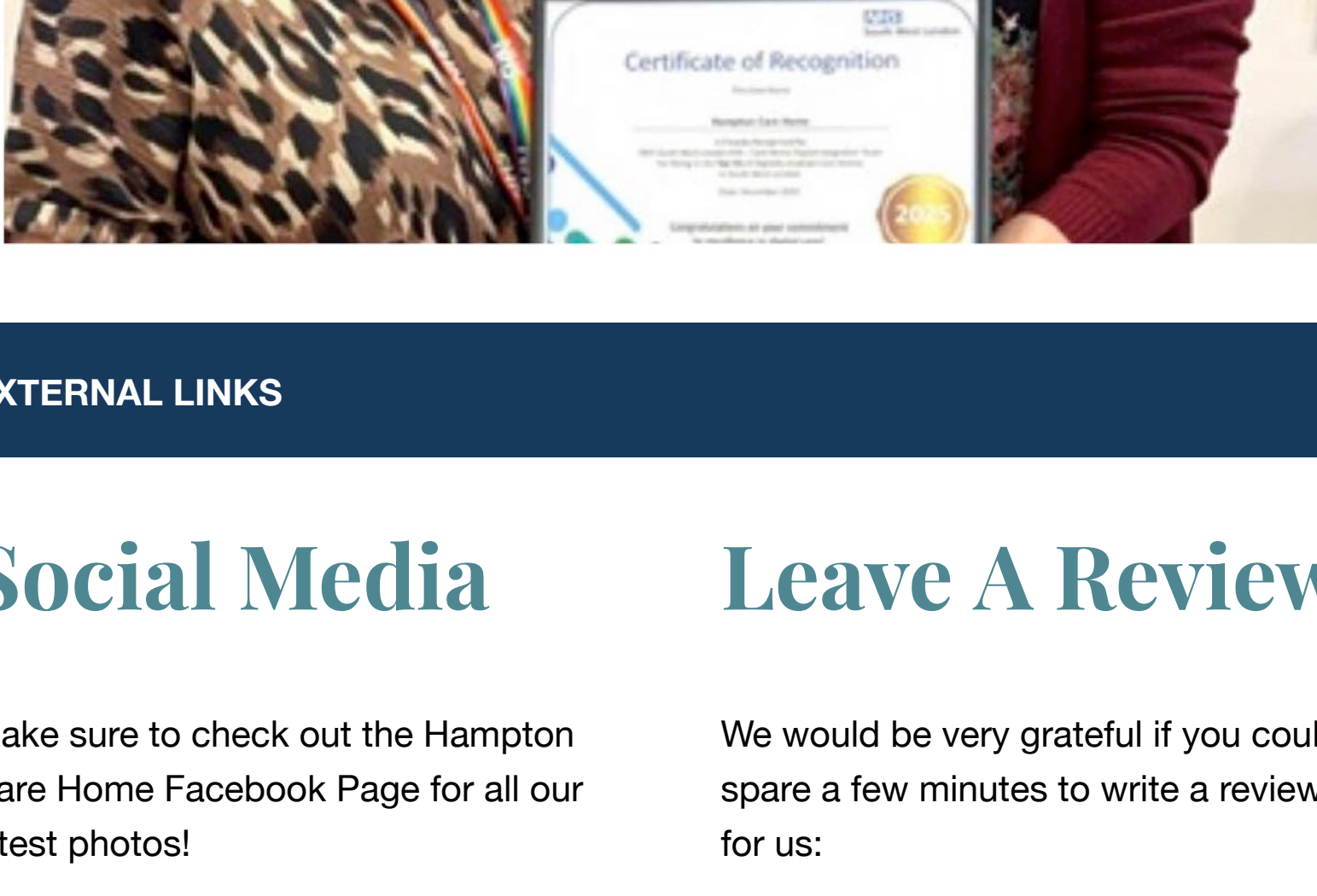


Celebrating Digital Excellence

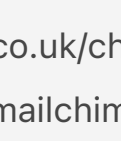

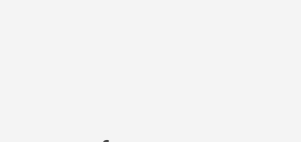
